Jodie foster on taxi driver

Jodie Foster shared some behind-the-scenes details about the role that marked the Hollywood star's first Oscar nomination. In a new interview with the British edition of OK! magazine, the 58-year-old reflected on her 1976 movie Taxi Driver, in which her stellar performance as a child sex assistant Iris got her a better supporting actress nomination. But Foster, who was 12 years old when the film was made, revealed that she had to undergo extensive psychological tests before acting in Martin Scorsese's crime drama to make sure she wouldn't be traumatized. I had to do some tests", he told the press. (Getty) Foster opened up about his controversial role in previous interviews, saying on The Graham Norton Show in 2016 his character made many "uncomfortable" on the set. "I was 12 years old and had made more movies than anyone else on the movie at that point", he recalled. "They were very uncomfortable for my character. Nobody knew how to direct me. " Scorsese would say something like this: "Unzip his fly" and he starts laughing and doesn't know what to do, so he hands it over to Robert De Niro and then Robert would tell me what to do. And it was even more 'Robert De Niro' then, even quieter and stranger. At the time, Foster had already made an infinity of children's films and was more a veteran than both his director and his coaster Robert De Niro. But De Niro taught her the alchemy of acting, which could be more than just believing. Foster would have been nominated for his first Academy Award for that role, then winning two more for The Accused and Silence of the Lambs, and she went on to be a acclaimed director in her right – a childish ambition – more recently than the movie Monster Money with George Clooney and Julia Roberts. But on the 40th anniversary of Scorsese's first masterpiece, he recalls the film's realization and attends his first Oscars as a teenager. Jodie Foster: "Sting is the Perfect Man"What was the audition for Taxi Driver like? I didn't really audition for Taxi Driver. I had made a movie with Martin Scorsese before calling Alice doesn't live here anymore and so she actually called my mother and she said: 'Porta Jodie in; we are making a new film.' And we read the script and thought he was crazy. I came to meet him in my school uniform, which was a gray folded skirt and white collar Peter Pan and a blue blazer. And she looked at him and said well, if you really think she can play this, I imagine, you know, it's up to you. Because, you know, that costume - I was literally at two different photos of shootings where we made your hat, your dress. We did it on Dakota Fanning... Yes, the costume for "Taxi Driver" has become very iconic, I think. I have to say that whoever knows me knows I'm not a dressed person. Shopping is like I stare at my eyes with pins. I don't care about buying clothes. But I was particularly unhappy wearing hot pants, a shelter top, and you know, crazy platform shoes. I mean, I was really unhappy. I went to my costume and started crying because I hated the costume so much. And I had to wear super leather-resistant pants, like cotton without underwear. I never wore underwear. So I was, I was just scared. I was looking forward to making costumes. But what you did in that movie is so amazing and you had to do scenes with De Niro. You were nervous? Well, before that, I did a lot of movies. So I probably had made more films than Robert de Niro and Martin Scorsese at that point. I probably did, I don't know, 10 or 11 movies. So I wasn't nervous. I think I'm too young to be nervous. But, uh, Robert de Niro decided to take me under his wing and he would constantly take me out to the bars and manage the lines with me, a kind of character, and then make improvisations, which I did not understand 100 percent, but at thewhere we havel started shooting. I figured out what he did. He really made me realize what a character was, something I didn't know at 12. And it's changed, my life has definitely changed. I remember returning home to the hotel room in New York City – I was staying at Essex House in Central Park South – and being only on fire, I really felt like, wow, I found something. That this world of cinema, and acting, could be more challenging than I thought. And when you, when you were in the show like that, do you have any idea you'd be done running? Did you see Scorsese somehow, or some other director, and you thought you were running? Was it even in your mind at that point? I knew I wanted to run from a young age. I was about six years old, I was making a television show called, Courtship of Eddie Padre and [actor] Bill Bixby came in one day and directed an episode and my eyes lit and I thought: 'Oh, wow, this guy's telling me what to do, he's throwing blows, and that's what I want to do.' So I knew it. I don't think I'm taking notes or anything, but my whole actor life was a movie school for me. And not only the director, but all the technicians and what goes to make a film and editing and how to tell a story. I am more interested in this than any other aspect of making movies; even than acting. And maybe what makes my acting different is that I despise myself more like a director. I don't think it's hard to go, but it's tiring and boring. It's a bad idea to actually head out, I think. I didn't know at the moment. What you end up getting on the screen is exactly what you expected, exactly what you prepared, but the great thing that actors bring to you is things you would never think. You really don't get that when you're acting and running the same time. You know, you're behind the camera in the curls. You do not have the opportunity to have the downtime you need as an actor to bring something fresh. So, I find out. The best news about acting and direction is that it is much easier to get a movie off the ground when you have a cried item in the movie that you can ensure, which is not paid too much. You can make sure your film has a better funding opportunity. So, it seems very brave. I've always heard him speakYou. I doto be intimidated? Are you intimidating before the first day of shooting or what scares you? Something scares you? I don't think I'm very brave. I think I'm brave for some things. I am confident about my opinions in terms of making movies. I'm sure of my instincts, creatively, but there are tons of things that are really just a child about. Although I have a fairly social job and I have to meet people and I am good at talking to people, I'm almost afraid to answer the phone and call someone and say: " Would you like to have dinner with me or have lunch with me?" I think I'm afraid I need someone or ask for help or small things other people have had in adolescence 101. When you were in college, and you gave up acting for a while, you were so scary for yourself or you, you missed acting? I never thought I'd come back to acting. I never thought I'd be an actor when I grew up. I thought my career would end when I was 18; That's what I've been told. And I got a big surprise that didn't happen. I knew I wanted to continue to support my family and I knew I would do the acting thing for as long as I could, especially because I wanted to continue film activity as a director and maybe as a writer. I thought it would be done. I'm trying to think what my first movie was after I left school. I don't think it was the Purchase, but the Purchase wasn't long after. Just before I did, I was thinking I'd go back to school and while I was shooting, I felt like my performance wasn't very good. I saw a rough cut of the movie and I thought: 'Oh, wow, I was really bad in that movie and I absolutely have to be done with acting.' So I took my parents and thought I'd go to school and then the movie came out. It was very good and I think I learned a lot from that experience. I learned it wasn't – that you could win an Oscar when you think you're bad. No, it was interesting why I thought I was bad and I think that at 25 or 26, your judgment on yourself and your underlying motivations is very poor. I didn't really understand the character I played in some ways. It was hard for me as a person to embrace who Sarah Tobias was like a character. How were the Oscars? It's very different from now. The Oscars were a big hit. My first nomination was when I went for the best support for Taxi Driver. You know you're not going to win so it was easier. I was like a tourist like the first Oscar ceremony I went to. But The Accused was a little incredible because I was the only one in the movie he was named. So I went to myself and go, "Well, where do I, what do I do now?" When I got my second Oscar for theof the Lambs was a rather special experience because everyone from the film had won. We won all the top five categories. I just... another name and then another sweaty and happy person would come to hug you and then would say another name and another sweaty and happy person would have embraced and we spent the night & € "we passed together at night and went to The same party and that was a party that was just our studio and only everyone from Orion, because our studio had just gone bankrupt. So we were all together in a party and it was just a fantastic night. Do you remember your speeches? Was it a blur for you or were you present for this? These are always a blur but now you see them on youtube so I know what I said. The first victory of Oscar was a bit more blurred than the second, even if, at the end of the night, he was also a blur. It's a very special moment in your life and you don't realize that you will never happen, you know. This is always true when you're young. You have something that happens that it's so spectacular and you don't realize that this is everything, but I continued to pinch myself so I hope I enjoyed it. It's so.
