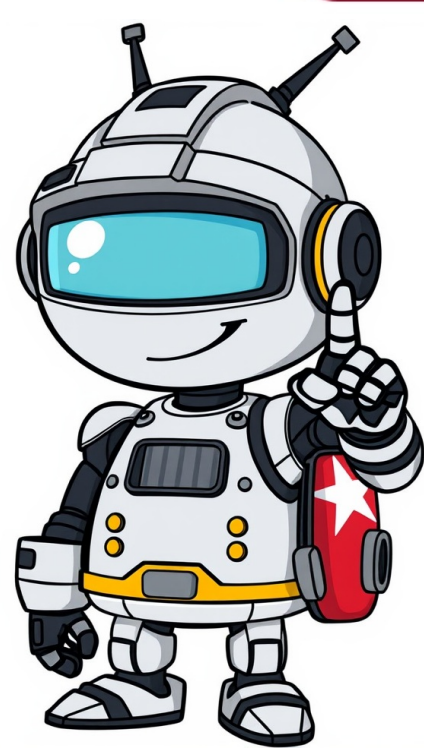

The battery degradation issue is often overhyped, so let me take a look at your SRAM AXS battery for you. Once all four LEDs are solid again, that means the charging is complete. It's very important to note that you should not leave your SRAM AXS battery plugged in for more than 24 hours at a time, as this could damage both the battery and charger. If you're not planning on using your bike for a while, it's best to store your SRAM AXS battery in a cool, dry place with a partial charge (around 50%).
