To replace your QLD White Card, you'll need to provide evidence of identity, which includes certified copies of three documents that have been verified by a Justice of the Peace or similar. You can get started by completing an online course and submitting required documents for replacement. The process usually takes 1-2 business days, but express delivery is also available for an extra \$12.00 incl GST. To obtain a replacement Queensland White Card, one must first identify the issuing Registered Training Organisation (RTO) through various means such as checking old emails or receipts, or asking an employer. If the RTO is no longer operational, contacting WorkSafe Queensland for guidance may be necessary. In some cases, repeating the White Card course with a new RTO might be required if records of previous training are unavailable. If you lose your White Card in QLD, contact your training provider for a replacement. If they're no longer operating, get a new card with another RTO in QLD. A WA White Card doesn't expire, but refresher courses are recommended after two years. You can use it in QLD and don't need to be an Aussie citizen. Admire Workplace Safety offers online webinars for those needing a new or replacement White Card. The White Card course is a mandatory education subject for workers in the construction industry, providing essential knowledge on workplace safety. To be issued a White Card, participants must bring required identity documents and a Unique Student Identifier (USI). The course is rated AQF level 1 and covers the same mandatory education subjects as other states and territories. In Queensland, however, the course must now be completed face-to-face, although residents of Tasmania and Western Australia can complete it online. You will learn about OHS PPE as part of a risk control measures strategy. This is the last step in protecting yourself from construction hazards. The course covers the commonly used PPE: hard hat, high visibility vest, safety glasses, and hearing protection. You must wear Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) correctly. If you are a Queensland resident taking the course virtually, you will need to purchase or own this equipment, costing around \$40. After buying it, you'll have to demonstrate its correct use with your webcam in real time. A White Card is needed to work in the construction industry and is evidence that you've completed general construction induction training. It's issued after completing training with a registered training organisation (RTO). The course content is defined by CPCCWHS1001 - Prepare to work safely in the construction industry, which is an accredited unit of competency. You will be given a White Card from RTOs on behalf of WorkSafe QLD. As of 2025, you must complete training in a classroom. However, if you live more than 100km away from the nearest RTO, you can apply for an exemption. The course is no longer available online to anyone before February 2019, so be aware that there's outdated information available. White Cards do not expire unless you haven't worked on construction sites for over two years. There are many training providers in Brisbane and the Gold Coast, but choose one based on location, price, reviews, and parking (which can be expensive). All White Cards are nationally recognised and can be used anywhere in Australia. You don't have to be 14 years old to get a QLD White Card, as this is only required in NSW. Some RTOs may set their own age restrictions but WorkSafe QLD does not specify one. To obtain a card, you need three identification documents with at least one showing your photo. The training requires a Unique Student Identifier (USI) and basic English language skills to be completed successfully. White Card replacements are limited to those issued by Queensland or WA. If you lost your White Card, you can replace it for \$27.50 within 1-3 business days. To obtain a replacement White Card in QLD, you need to meet certain requirements. Firstly, you must have completed one of the approved construction safety induction units with a Registered Training Organisation (RTO) at some point. This means sending us a copy of your statement of attainment from when you successfully completed the course. We'll then provide you with a Declaration outlining how your card was lost, stolen or destroyed, which you need to submit online. Next, upload certified copies of your identity documents into your account, ensuring they meet the Evidence of Identity requirements. You can check our website for more information on this process. Note: After 15th August 2022, online white card training is only available to residents of Western Australia and Tasmania. In other states, you'll need to complete a new CPCCWHS1001 course if your original statement of attainment is lost or you haven't completed the required courses. It's essential to have a valid White Card when working in the construction industry in Queensland. A White Card verifies that you've completed necessary safety training, allowing you to work safely and responsibly on construction sites. While your White Card doesn't technically expire, if you haven't worked in the industry for two years or more, you may need to complete another course. To check if your White Card is still valid in QLD, locate your unique number printed on your card. If you've misplaced it, contact the Registered Training Organisation that issued your card, or WorkSafe Queensland may be able to assist you with your personal details. Card validity confirmed: Check old emails or documents for White Card details. If not found, apply for a replacement card through RTOs. In some cases, retake online QLD course if initial training is outdated or details are no longer on record.
