## Clat result 2024

The Consortium of National Law Universities has announced the results for the Common Law Admission Test (CLAT) 2024, which can be accessed by logging into the candidate's account on the official website: consortiumofnlus.ac.in. The test was conducted on December 3, 2023, and resulted in a pass percentage of 96.45%. Applicants are encouraged to apply for CLAT 2024 to unlock opportunities in legal education. The Vice Chancellors of member NLUs will provide insights into the benefits of pursuing law as a career. The CLAT 2024 scorecard includes essential information such as the All India Rank (AIR), category, and merit rank. To get into these institutions, candidates must score impressively on the Common Law Admission Test (CLAT). The cutoffs for admission to top-tier NLUs like NLSIU Bangalore and NALSAR Hyderabad are extremely competitive, with closing ranks below 250. \*\*Mid-Tier and Lower-Tier NLUs\*\* Other notable NLUs, such as GNLU Gandhinagar and MNLU Mumbai, have a strong preference among students, particularly those interested in corporate and litigation careers. These institutions offer robust opportunities for growth and development. Lower-tier NLUs like DSNLU Visakhapatnam and NLU Nagpur are slowly gaining recognition, with improving closing ranks over the years. \*\*CLAT 2025 Expected Rank\*\* A table is provided to give an idea of how CLAT marks correspond to expected ranks in admission. The analysis suggests that: \* Candidates scoring above 115 can expect a rank between 1-10 and have a strong chance of securing admission at top NLUs like NLSIU Bangalore. \* Those who score between 100-109 can expect a rank between 51-200, making them eligible for top NLUs like GNLU Gandhinagar or NLU Jodhpur. \* A good score of 90-99 can secure admission to mid-tier NLUs such as RMLNLU Lucknow and MNLU Mumbai. \*\*State-Wise Analysis\*\* The CLAT results are analyzed state-wise to give a better understanding of how candidates from different regions perform. NLU Delhi does not consider CLAT results for admissions and conducts its own AILET test instead. 25 NLUs offer admissions based on CLAT results. The Consortium of NLUs administers the Common Law Admission Test (CLAT), which is a national-level admission test for UG and PG law courses. For top NLUs, a general candidate must score 80-90 marks in CLAT to secure admission. The cut-offs for Tier-2 and Tier-3 NLUs are lower. Here are the CLAT 2024 Cutoff Ranks for UG admissions at some of the top NLUs: NLSIU Bangalore (1st), Nalsar University of Law, Hyderabad (3rd), NUJS Kolkata (4th), GNLU Gandhinagar (8th), and NLU Lucknow (20th). CLAT is a centralised national-level entrance exam for admissions into most NLUs. The exam is conducted annually in offline mode, and the scores are used to determine admissions at UG and PG levels. CLAT 2024 Result: Key Details and Insights The CLAT 2024 UG exam was conducted in a single shift, a change from previous years that had two shifts. The scorecard will include essential information such as total marks secured, overall rank, category rank, and other pertinent details. After the result declaration, an all-India CLAT merit list will be published, and candidates selected will receive invitations for counseling and seat allotment. Registration begins on December 12. The Common Law Admission Test (CLAT) scores are significant for admission to 24 national law universities and various affiliated law schools. The CLAT cut-off serves as a benchmark determining eligibility for admission to these institutions, with expectations for elevated cut-offs anticipated this year due to reports indicating the exam's perceived ease. The CLAT 2024 admission process has been initiated by Common Law Admission Test. The online application form for UG and PG admissions is available now.
