And then she threw me my pitch that I know that I can hit," Hensley said, describing the moment before her impressive hit.Hensley, who caught a thousand innings and won state championships twice during her high school career, credits her travel team, Fury Platinum X, for helping her reach her full potential. Her coach, Jeremy Higdon, expressed pride in her achievements."To be an SEC athlete, you know, something I think that we always thought was there when she was younger, and to see it actually play out was just been really, really satisfying," Higdon said.This fall, Hensley will take her talents to the University of Kentucky, where she will play for the Wildcats. Higdon shared his confidence in her future success, saying... "She's going to do the work, and she's going to have the right mentality going into it."While Hensley is excited about her athletic future, she is also focused on her academics. "I'm going to double major in finance and accounting, and so I'm really excited," she said.Having played softball in Chattanooga since she was 4 years old, Hensley is eager for the next chapter in Lexington. "I really see myself growing there, not only as an athlete, but as a person," she said.Hensley and the UK softball team will enjoy a home-field advantage next May when the SEC softball tournament takes place at John Cropp Stadium in Lexington. Redshirt freshman infielder Taylor Pannell played heroic on Sunday to cap off the sweep for the Lady Vols as the Milan, Illinois native hit a walk-off home run against the Wildcats.With the Lady Vols clinching the outright title and Florida sweeping its series against No. 8 Texas A&M, the Gators moved into the No. 2 seed in this year's tournament. Winners of nine of their last 12 games, the Gators won by the rule-ahead rule on Sunday against the Aggies, 11-3.Texas A&M, Arkansas and Missouri round out the top five in the field. That wouldn't last long, though. After nearly eight innings of scoreless softball Taylor Pleasants knocked in a single to center field in the bottom of the 14th to score Sierra Daniel from third base to give the Tigers their sixth walk-off of the season. They'll play top-seeded Tennessee to begin day three on Thursday. The second matchup of the day saw 5-seed Missouri control their matchup against 13-seed Ole Miss after scoring three early runs. The Rebels wouldn't find the scoreboard until the seventh, but by that time it was too late thanks to the pitching performance of Laurin Krings and Taylor Pannell. Excitement continued in game three, seeing 7-seed Georgia and 10-seed Auburn battle into extra innings at two runs a piece. After a pitchers duel sent this game into 14 innings tied at 2-2 seven combined runs from both teams were scored in the 14th as Bulldogs catcher Sarah Gordon worked an 0-1 count over the fence to walk it off for Georgia, who will now face 2-seed Florida on Thursday. This game broke the LSU-Alabama record for the longest game in SEC Tournament history by nearly 30 minutes, playing for a whopping 4 hours and 21 minutes. After all the fireworks throughout the day, the night ended with a little less of a bang as 11-seed South Carolina defeated 6-seed Mississippi State 8-4. The Gamecocks stormed off to an 8-1 lead through four and a half innings before the Bulldogs tried to rally with a three-run bomb by first baseman Madisyn Kennedy in the bottom of the fifth stanza. That homer would prove to be the last of the scoring as the Gamecocks would advance to the next round. Gamecocks second baseman Denver Bryant led the way with four hits producing two RBIs while also scoring twice herself. South Carolina will now face the 2-seed Texas A&M Aggies to finish off Thursdays action.
