But I think he's wounded - more dangerous than ever. Voldemort knows we're onto him now, [he walks among the dead guards and goblins at Malfoy Manor, accompanied by Nagini] The boy has discovered our secret, Nagini. You must stay close, [Narcissa surveys the corpses as Voldemort Disapparates; among the dead is Griphook, still clutching the Sword of Gryffindor]Voldemort summoned Harry through the portrait of the Black Lake, using the magic that only he could control. Professor McGonagall shouted at Harry for breaking out the window and flying away without permission, but her anger was overshadowed by the need to protect the school from Voldemort's followers. [Harry turns to the sword sitting in the corner behind him] Hermione: [she, Harry, and Ron step out of Griphook's room and close the door as Bill and Luna are in the kitchen below] Are you thinking there's a Horcrux in Bellatrix's vault? Harry: She was terrified when she thought we'd been in there. She kept asking us what else we'd been in there. I bet you anything there's a Horcrux in there, another piece of his soul. Let's find it and kill it, and then we're one step closer to killing him. Ron: And what happens when we find it? How are we supposed to destroy it now that you've given the sword to Griphook? Harry: [as Olivander's bedroom door opens] I'm still working on that part. Fleur: [stepping out after checking in on Olivander] He's weak. [Harry, Ron, and Hermione walk past her into the bedroom] He's After You! [Harry, Ron, and Hermione enter Olivander's bedroom; he is sitting next to the window and looks up at them as they enter] Olivander: Yes? Harry: Mr. Olivander, I need to ask you a few questions about my wand. While Olivander took Bellatrix's wand and identified its characteristics, he revealed that the Elder Wand had allegiance issues due to being taken from Draco Malfoy. Harry expressed skepticism about wands having feelings, but Olivander emphasized the wand chooses the wizard. The Deathly Hallows were discussed, with rumors existing among wizards, including the Elder Wand, Cloak of Invisibility, and Resurrection Stone. However, Olivander claimed only to have conveyed unverified information. He then gasps for air as he surfaces before it shows Voldemort in shock again. Gasping, Harry swims for shore. Harry: [as he, Ron, and Hermione step out of the water and onto shore] He knows. You-Know-Who. [they walk onto the grassy hill] He knows we broke into Gringotts. He knows what we took. And he knows we're hunting Horcruxes. Hermione: How is it you know? Harry: I saw him. Hermione: You let him in? Harry: You can't do that! Harry: Hermione, I can't always help it. Well, maybe I can. I don't no. Ron: Never mind. What happened? Harry: [as they come to the top of the hill] Well, he's angry. And scared, too. He knows if we find and destroy all the Horcruxes, we'll be able to kill him. [Hermione sets her bag down and gets to her knees as Harry holds out his hands, motioning for her to give him the Essence of Dittany] I reckon he'll stop at nothing to make sure we don't find the rest. Harry turns back to help them, flying back to grab Malfoy's hand just as the books under the table fall, causing it to tilt. He grabs the hold of Malfoy just in time, pulling him onto his broom while Ron takes Blaise from behind. As they all fly over the flames, Hermione spots a wall of fire ahead and knows the door is just past it. She casts a spell to put out the flames, making an opening for them to rocket through. They land safely in the corridor as a fireball emits from the door to the Room of Requirement. Malfoy gets up and flees the scene, but Harry glances back at him before focusing on the diadem in front of him. Hermione throws a Basilisk fang to Harry, who catches it mid-air and stabs the diadem with it, causing black smoke to erupt from the ruptured diadem. Ron kicks the diadem back into the flames as three fiery visages of Voldemort appear among the flames. The doors close just in time, shutting out the inferno. In another part of the story, Nagini recoils while Voldemort shudders due to the diadem's destruction. Harry sits next to a post, shaking with the same reason. Voldemort recovers from his "seizure" and turns away as Pius Thicknesse and some Death Eaters approach him. He points the Elder Wand at Pius and casts an Avada Kedavra spell, killing him. Voldemort then looks at Nagini and continues walking, pointing at her to follow closely behind. They Disapparate as Harry, Ron, and Hermione rush down the stairs to the boathouse at the bottom. Inside, they overhear a meeting between Voldemort and Snape. Harry Potter stood tall, his eyes fixed on Voldemort's wand. The Elder Wand, also known as the Deathstick, had been a crucial factor in their final battle. As Snape lay mortally wounded at their feet, Harry remembered the wise words of Albus Dumbledore: "It is our choices, Harry, that show what we truly are, far more than our abilities." We move cautiously through Gringotts, avoiding suspicion as we make our way towards the counter where the vault is located. We enter my vault. Head Goblin: [still not looking at her] Identification? Hermione: [as Harry and Griphook watch from under the cloak] I hardly think that'll be necessary. Head Goblin: [finally looks up and recognizes her] Madame Lestrange. [Hermione narrows her eyes; he turns and walks away from the desk] Hermione: I don't like to be kept waiting. Griphook: [whispering from under the cloak] They know. They know she's an imposter. [Ron grows nervous as some of the goblins look at them] They've been warned. Ron: [nervously looks at the guard standing near the entrance who is now slowly walking towards them, then turns back to the counter] Harry... what do we do, Harry? [the Head Goblin returns with another goblin named Bogrod.] Bogrod: Madame Lestrange, would you mind presenting your wand? Hermione: And why should I do that? Bogrod: It's the bank's policy.
