## How do you descale a nespresso lattissima

Nespresso® machines are nifty appliances, always there to provide a quick and easy coffee. It is a give and take relationship, though. It provides the quality coffee we require, but we also need to take care of it to retain that quality. This is where descaling your machine comes in. Caring for your Nespresso® Machine Care comes in the form of descaling and cleaning. Descaling is crucial in removing the build-up of calcium and magnesium deposits that form limescale on the heating element and thermoblock in your machine. Calcium and Magnesium Build-up in Nespresso® Machines Calcium and magnesium deposits come from the minerals in your tap water. The “harder” the water, the more minerals present. Each brew with your Nespresso® machine causes the deposits to accumulate and develop limescale. Accumulation of limescale on your machine’s heating components prevents them from heating the water to its optimal temperature, resulting in cold, poor-tasting coffee. How often should you descale your Coffee Machine Certain machines such as the Nespresso® Lattissima, and VertuoPlus inform you when to descale. On the Lattissima an orange light on the button will alert you, and the VertuoPlus will shine half green, half orange. It’s okay if your machine does not alert you. Most manufacturers recommend that you descale your machine every 3-6 months to keep the heating components in tip-top condition. The recommended usage also depends on the water hardness in your area. You can find out if your water is hard with a simple and easy DIY test. You will need a clean and clear empty bottle with a cap, and some pure liquid soap. Fill the bottle one-third full of tap water, add a few drops of liquid soap and shake well for a few seconds. If there is a lack of foamy bubbles and the water appears cloudy and/or milky, your water is likely hard. How to Descale your Coffee Machine First check your machine manufacturer’s instruction manual for descaling and rinsing procedures. Pour 100 ml (single dose) of Caffenu® Descaler into the water tank of your machine, with 500 ml of water to make the descaling solution. Place a large container under the brew spout and run a brewing cycle to dispense approximately 200 ml of the solution into container. If your machine has a steam wand, then run an additional 200 ml of the solution through it, into the container. Repeat steps 2 & 3 until all the solution has been dispensed, allowing the machine to sit for 5 minutes between each cycle. Rinse the tank then fill it with clean water and repeat steps 2 & 3 with clean water. Once done, wipe the machine and surface around it with a damp cloth. Regularly descaling your Nespresso machine is crucial to extend the life of the machine and to ensure it keeps producing high quality and tasty coffee the way it was designed to.In this guide, we'll take you through the step-by-step process you need to follow to descale your Nespresso® Lattissima Touch machine.The process should be undertaken a minimum of once every 3 months to avoid long term damage to your machine.There are many makes, models and brands of coffee machine on the market. This guide is intended only for the Nespresso Lattissima Touch made by De'Longhi. If you have a different machine, please check out our other guides HERE.Nespresso offer their propriety descaling kit, which you can purchase from any Nespresso machine retailer. We think this is a little expensive, and prohibits people descaling their machines as often as they need. You can pick up our Green Pods Descaling Solution which works out cheaper, or pick up an eco-friendly alternative here on Amazon.What is 'descaling'All coffee machines build up deposits of calcium and lime over time. These come from tiny amounts of mineral salts that are naturally found in our water supplies. They're completely harmless, and in fact we need them to stay healthy, but they will build up in hot water appliances over time. "Descaling" is the act of stripping these mineral deposits from your machine's internal surfaces. To keep your Nespresso functioning properly, you should remove these buildups by descaling regularly.How often should you descale your Nespresso Machine?Nespresso recommends that you descale your machine every three months or 300 coffees - whichever comes first.That means if you use your machine often you may need to descale more frequently. Some examples descaling frequencies are shown in the table below.Number of coffees per dayRecommended descaling frequency1-2Every 3 months3-4Every 3 months5-8Every 2 months8-10Every monthThe frequency of descaling also largely depends on what is known as your 'water hardness' - which essentially means how much mineral salts are present in your town or city's water supply. Areas with high water hardness will require you to descale your machine more often, and areas with low water hardness can reduce the amount of maintenance required.Some models of Nespresso machine including the Lattissima Touch have a warning light that flashes to alert you that the machine needs to be descaled. How long will it take?The entire process to descale your Nespresso should take between 20 and 30 minutes.What you will need.To descale your Nespresso Lattissima Touch machine, you'll need a descaling solution kit. A two-pack kit that works for all machines costs about \$20 from the Nespresso website. Alternatively, we're created our own ecological product which you can check out here.What you'll need:How to descale the Nespresso Lattissima TouchThe descaling process can will take you around 20-30 minutes. We recommend decaling first, and then taking the extra time to also clean your extraction unit as this tends to build up with coffee residue over time. When mixing up the descaling mixture, make sure to read the instructions to determine the correct ratio of water to add. If using our Green Pods Descaler you'll need to add 3-parts water for every 1-part descaler.Here's our step-by-step guide to descaling your Nespresso Lattissima Touch coffee machine: note that the Lattissima Touch has a built-in descaling warning light which will come if the machines sensors pick up that descaling is required.Turn on the machine. Empty the drip tray and make sure that all capsules have been removed from the slot and tray. Place an empty 1 litre or bigger container under the spout.Fill the water tank with around 500ml of clean water and descaling solution. Mix thoroughly and return the tank to the machine.Open the bottom compartment to retrieve the descaling nozzle and insert it into the milk spout. This will put the machine into descaling mode. The descaler-light will start to blink - indicating that the descaling program is activatedPress the milk-foam-button to start descaling your machine. The solution will flow alternately through the coffee nozzle and hot milk nozzleWhen the descaling solution has been through the coffee machine twice, you may discard the mixture (down the sink is fine) and thoroughly rinse the water containers and water tank.Fill, and insert the tank back into the machine. Then press the milk-foam button again to rinse your machine.Allow all the water to run through the machine. When the process is finished, the machine will automatically switch into energy-saving mode. Remove the descaling nozzle and store back in the undercarriage.Congratulations: Your machine has now been successfully descaled!Next we recommend cleaning the capsule holder of your machine to remove and coffee residue.Cleaning Your Nespresso Lattissima TouchIt's hard to get in the habit of rinsing you're Nespresso machine after every use. Unfortunately, because of this, coffee sediment can build up in the spout of the machine over time and can even block the whole system.To clean the coffee buildup inside the spout try straightening out a paper clip, pipe cleaner, or q-tip and scrape up around within the spout. Once done close the lever in rinse through a couple of times to wash out any particles that have become dislodged.Coffee grinds can also get built up against the spikey pyramids inside the capsule mechanism that are used to pop open the foil lid of the coffee capsules. This can result in a blocked or stifled flow as the water has trouble passing through the pods.We recommend using an old toothbrush to scrub the inside of the capsule mechanism clean from time to time to avoid this from happening. Again, once done close the lever in rinse through a couple of times to wash out any particles that have become dislodged.Frequently Asked Questions:We get a lot of questions about the descaling process. Here's some of the answers to these frequently asked questions.How much descaling solution should I use in my Lattissima Touch Nespresso machine?Each descaling product comes at a different concentration, so you'll need to read the instructions on the label to see how much to use, and how much water to add. In terms of the total amount of solution to mix up, we recommend making enough to completely fill the water tank on your machine.How often do I need to descale my Lattissima Touch Nespresso machine?Nespresso recommends that you descale your machine every three months or 300 coffees - whichever comes first.That means if you use your machine often you may need to descale more frequently. Some examples descaling frequencies are shown in the table below.Number of coffees per dayRecommended descaling frequency1-2Every 3 months3-4Every 3 months5-8Every 2 months8-10Every monthCan you use vinegar instead of descaling solution?Scientifically speaking, cleaning your Nespresso machine vinegar is almost exactly the same as with commercial descaler solution.Unfortunately, however, vinegar tends to peel off the scale build up in flakes which could clog your machine causing irreparable damage. We've heard numerous cases of people having to throw out their Nespresso machine because of this. We'd recommend sticking with a commercial descaling product.What is a descaling solution made of?Descaling solution is generally an acidic chemical that is capable of dissolving mineral salts such as oxides and carbonates. Notable descaling agents include acetic acid, citric acid and lactic acid. These are all food safe chemicals, however citric and acetic acid do impart a more noticeable taste to the machine, thus lactic is typically preferred.Can you make descaling solution?You can make your own descaling solution using vinegar or citric acid, though we'd recommend using a commercial descaling product in a concentration that is proven not to damage your machine.Can I use any descaler in my Nespresso Lattissima Touch?Yes, in fact, you can use it for any brand of coffee machine.What happens if you don't descale your coffee machine?Scale builds up inside the pipes restricting the flow of water. If this happens inside the thermoblock (Nespresso's heating element) water won't be able to reach its optimal brewing temperature. When this happens it's impossible to extract the full flavor from the coffee pods and the flavour will become weak. Severe scale buildup can clog water flow completely, causing a machine to stop working. Is descaling solution toxic?Our Nespresso descaling solution is completely non-tox and ecofriendly. It's made from lactic acid which is food safe in moderate doses.
