With the release of version 3.7, FBReader now opens Radium LCP-protected eBooks, providing a safer reading experience. The free and premium editions are available, with the free version installable from Google Play or this site, while the premium edition can be purchased from these platforms for a fee. However, users who have purchased the premium edition can also download it directly from our site. It's worth noting that purchasing the premium edition supports the FBReader project. The app is available in two versions: free and premium. The latest release is 3.8.6, published on March 19th, 2025. FBReader develops two branches of the Android app in parallel: the stable branch, version 3.7*, which includes tested features, and the beta series, version 4.0, which explores experimental solutions. While the stable branch is recommended for most users, those who want to access new features can try the beta. The app supports multiple eBook formats, including text-based ePub and fb2 files, as well as image-based PDF, DjVu, and comic files. However, some of these features require additional modules or plugins. For developers, FBReader source code is now closed due to licensing issues. Instead, the FBReader SDK is available as a commercial framework distributed in binary form. Users can download the SDK and test it before deciding on their own project.
