Juneteenth: What You Need to Know About the Upcoming Holiday Juneteenth is on June 19 this year, falling on a Wednesday. It commemorates the end of slavery in the U.S., which occurred when Union Army Gen. Gordon Granger told enslaved people in Galveston, Texas, that they had been liberated nearly three years after President Abraham Lincoln signed the Emancipation Proclamation. Employers are more likely to observe Juneteenth now than ever before - about 40% of employers offer it as a public holiday, with some states recognizing it as a public holiday for state workers. The United States Post Office will be closed on Wednesday, but UPS and FedEx locations will operate normally. Major banks like Bank of America, TD Bank, Chase, and Wells Fargo will also be closed, while the stock market and most federal offices are shut down. However, online banking services and ATMs remain accessible. Most retailers, such as Walmart and Target, will stay open during regular hours on Juneteenth. Federal offices closed on June 19 for Juneteenth, plan ahead if needed; banks, USPS, FedEx, and UPS open. Juneteenth holiday marks the emancipation of slaves in Texas in 1865. Bureau of Motor Vehicles in Kentucky will be closed, while public schools should already be out but may still follow federal schedule. Some businesses might not be open, so check local stores or restaurants before visiting. Federal offices and post offices are closed on June 19 for Juneteenth, while the stock market will also observe the holiday. Private schools and universities have different schedules; check their calendars to confirm closure status. Federal recognition of Juneteenth was made in 2021 by President Biden through legislation. While many businesses will be open, including retailers and fast-food chains, some organizations are giving their employees the day off as a paid holiday. Several major companies have declared Juneteenth an annual company holiday, with some giving employees the day off or offering extra pay. Companies like Nike, Target, and Best Buy are observing this day in various ways. For instance, Nike announced in 2020 that it would recognize Juneteenth as a paid federal holiday for its U.S. and Puerto Rican employees, providing them with educational opportunities to honor Black history and culture. Ride-sharing app Lyft is also honoring Juneteenth as a paid company holiday for corporate employees, although this policy does not apply to independent contractors like Lyft drivers. Zillow is giving its employees the day off for Juneteenth, encouraging them to reflect, volunteer, educate themselves, or engage in activism to commemorate the end of slavery in the U.S. Tech companies such as Google have made Juneteenth a paid company holiday and have hosted company wide learning events prior to the day off. Certain retail corporations, like Target and Starbucks, will remain open but pay their employees time-and-a-half on Juneteenth. Amazon has not yet made Juneteenth a company holiday but is offering online learning opportunities and adopting an "anti-meeting approach" to the day. On Wednesday, June 19, 2024, U.S. Post Offices will be delivered. Banks will also be closed, following most government operations. However, most grocery stores and retailers, including Costco, Walmart, Target, and Starbucks, will remain open on Juneteenth. This day marks a crucial moment in U.S. history when, in 1865, Major General Gordon Granger arrived in Galveston, Texas, to inform enslaved people that they were free, as slavery had been officially abolished nationwide. President Joe Biden officially made Juneteenth a federal holiday in 2021, declaring it a national holiday to commemorate this significant event. Traditionally, people celebrate Juneteenth with parades, educational activities, family gatherings, and cooking holiday food. To honor the occasion, many businesses close on June 19 to allow employees to participate in celebrations. Before making a last-minute run for essentials like banks or grocery stores, check if local businesses are open. We compiled a list of which institutions will be open or closed during Juneteenth, including banks, schools, government services, and stores. Are banks open on Juneteenth? Most major banks, such as Bank of America and Wells Fargo, follow the Federal Reserve System's holiday schedule, closing on June 19. However, ATM branches typically operate normally. The stock market will also be closed on June 19 and mail delivery won't occur. Starting in 2022, the USPS recognizes Juneteenth as a holiday for full-time and part-time career employees. UPS will provide regular pickup and delivery services, while Fedex stores remain open. Are schools and universities may operate as usual. DMV offices across the country are also closed on June 19 in honor of Juneteenth. Stores open on Juneteenth as an annual company holiday but will still be open to customers. Companies like Nike and Adidas have announced they will remain closed for the third consecutive year, allowing employees a day off. * **New York Stock Exchange **: The New York Stock Exchange will close on Monday, June 19th * **Celebration events**: * A concert honoring Juneteenth will be performed by The Roots at the Hollywood Bowl on Sunday, June 19th at 8 p.m. ET. * An associate professor from Cornell University suggests that this holiday should have been officially recognized years ago due to the long history of neglecting slavery and racism in America.
