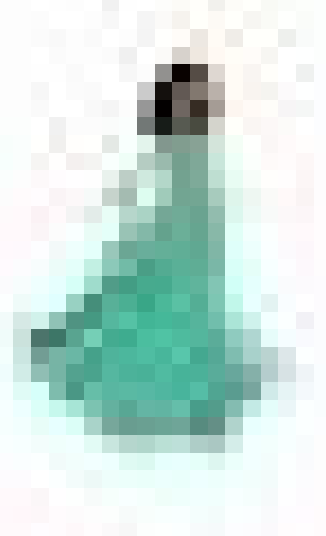

For these reasons, it is beneficial to learn how to use correctly Signs. The punctuation marks are symbols that indicate the structure and the organization of the language written, as well as the intonation and the breaks to be observed during reading aloud. In written English, punctuation is fundamental to clarify the meaning of sentences. For example: Today I need to buy milk, bread, apples and potatoes.Adding a comma can completely change the meaning of a sentence, so it is important to put it in the right place.For example: Let's eat Callum! That means we'll eat Callum!Compare it to this: Let's eat, Callum! A comma is used correctly after eating, so we are eating with Callum à phew!In longer sentences, you can use commas to separate additional information (known as àparentheses') to make the sentence easier to read.For example: Edinburgh, the capital of Scotland, is famous for its castle. Commas can be used to divide sentences that have more than one sentence, to make them easier to read.For example: When Albert saw the food, his belly began to buzz.This sentence has a secondary clause: "When Albert saw the food". The subordinate clauses do not make sense on their own, as they require that the main part of the sentence ("his tummy started buzzing") be completely clear. When you have two clauses like these, they must be separated by a comma.If the clauses make sense on their own, you don't need to use a comma. Instead, write the clauses as separate sentences.For example: Albert was eager to eat.
